Sub:-Art High School Leaving Certificate (AHSLC) Examination-  
March 2017 - Reg.

The Art High School Leaving Certificate Examination March 2017 will be conducted from 08/03/2017 to 27/03/2017 according to the time table as per this notification.

The examination is based on the revised curriculum prepared in accordance with the concept of continuous evaluation and its 9 point grading system. In part A, there will be 7 papers for the written examination and part B, there will be 5 papers including practical examination. Information Technology theory examination will not be a written examination but it will be alongwith the practical examination using computer. The details are given below.

The Examination will be held at the Kerala Kalamandalam Govt. Art HSS Cheruthuruthy, Vallathol Nagar, Thrissur – 678531

The Principal, Kerala Kalamandalam Govt Art HSS Cheruthuruthy will be the Chief Superintendent for conducting the examination.

### **Details of IT Examination for Private Candidates**

Candidates who have attended the IT Examination before 2016 academic year and not qualified for the IT examination can write the examination in the old scheme. For such candidates CE, TE, and Practical examination will be in the score 10, 10 and 20 respectively.

Those who have not qualified in the Information Technology (IT) examination held in March 2015 can sit for a re-test along with the regular candidates of 2016-2017.

## **1. CATEGORY OF CANDIDATES**

### **a) Regular Candidates**

Students in Std. X for the academic year 2016-2017 can appear for the examination as regular candidates. They should also have undergone the CE for each paper, under the new pattern of grading system introduced. The candidates who have not acquired the required percentage of attendance (ie: 85%) will not be admitted for the examination.

### **b) Private Candidates Old Scheme (PCO)**

Those candidates who have appeared in the examination in grading system in old scheme and obtained D&E grades in any paper or papers can appear for the Examination as Private candidates old scheme. Such candidates need only appear for the papers in which they have obtained D&E grades.

**c) Private Candidate New Scheme (PCN)**

Candidates who had appeared the examination for the academic years 2011-2012, 2012-2013 , 2013-2014 , 2014 - 2015 & 2015-2016 and not obtained eligibility for higher studies can appear for the examination as private candidates new scheme. Those candidates shall appear for the examination March 2017 under the new scheme which came into force from 2011-2012 academic year.

**d) Attendance Recouped Candidate (ARC)**

Candidates who have undergone the continuous evaluation process during the course of Standard X and not able to attend the Public Examination due to lack of attendance can appear as Attendance Recouped Candidates in March 2017. Such candidates should get necessary attendance during this year.

**e) Betterment of Result (BT)**

Candidates who have already qualified for higher studies and want to improve their grades can appear for the examination and can make better their results as per the following conditions.

1. The appearance for the betterment of result will be within a period of three years from the year of the examination last attended.
2. The candidates should not have obtained any higher qualification during this period.
3. They should appear for examination only as full course.

**II. DETAILS REGARDING IT EXAMINATION**

As per GO(Rt)4610/2012/GEEdn dtd. 28.09.2012 the maximum score for IT Examination is fixed as 50. Out of this 40 score will be for term end evaluation and 10 score for continuous evaluation. Out of the 40 score, 10 score is for theory examination and 30 score for practical examination. Theory examination will be conducted along with the practical examination.

## **General Instruction for IT Examination**

1. AHSLC IT practical examination March 2017 will be conducted using the free software only.
2. IT Theory examination will be conducted along with the practical examination.
3. The evaluation of Theory will be done with the help of software and practical examination will be done by the invigilators as in the previous years.

## **III. PRACTICAL EXAMINATION**

### **(a) Information Technology**

1. The maximum score for IT practical examination is 30. Out of this, 28 score is for evaluating the IT skills of the candidates and 2 score for maintaining the IT Practical Workbook. Practical examination for 28 score conducted using software will be evaluated by the teachers posted as invigilators. The software will have provisions for recording the score awarded by the invigilators and the score for maintaining the Practical Workbook.
2. The software working in Linux Operating System will be provided in Malayalam, English, Tamil and Kannada languages for the conduct of examinations.
3. The maximum time for the practical examination will be 60 minutes. (Time taken by the invigilator for evaluation will not be included). The time taken by the candidate for attending the tasks will be displayed in the examination software.
4. There will be no revaluation of IT Theory/ Practical Examinations.
5. The score awarded to a candidate in the public examination should be confidential. Therefore the score awarded to the candidates for IT practical examination will not be published at the examination centres.

### **(b) Art Subjects**

Practical Examination in Art subjects will be commenced after the written tests. The candidates should contact the Chief Superintendent of the Centre to ascertain the date of practical examination.

#### **IV. SAVE A YEAR (SAY) EXAMINATION**

Those candidates (Regular) who are not qualified for higher studies in the 2017 March AHSLC Examination are eligible for appearing the Save A Year (SAY) Examination which is proposed to be conducted by May 2017. Separate notification will be issued later in this regard.

Minimum D+ Grade for each Subject and C+ for practical subjects should be obtained to be eligible for higher studies.

**VII. a. EXAMINATION FEE**

The examination fee should be collected and remitted to treasury under the Head of Account "0202-01-102-99-Examination fee" and cost of certificate should be remitted under the Head of Account "0202-01-102-92-other receipts".

**b. Exemption from payment of fee**

Students belonging to Below Poverty Line (BPL) appearing for the AHSLC Examination after completion of the course in Kerala Kalamandalam Government Art HSS Cheruthuruthy are exempted from the payment of fee for the first appearance, provided such appearance is at the close of the academic year in which the candidate studies in Standard X for the first time (G.O.(Rt ) 3668/2001 GE. Dated, 03.10.2001). Attendance Recouped, Betterment candidates are not eligible for this concession. In the case of regular students belonging to SC and other eligible communities they will be allowed such free appearance for two chances within a period of 3 years with effect from the date of completion of the course at Kerala Kalamandalam Govt.Art High School (G.O. (MS) 32/74/GE. Dated, 18.02.1974).

Students belonging to ST are eligible for exemption from the payment of exam fee for 5 years inclusive of the benefit enjoyed prior to February 1981 (G.O.(RT) 680/81/GE. Dated, 25.02.1981)

Head of Institution may collect the examination fee and remit the amount to the Treasury and original Chalan receipt to be forwarded to this Office along with A& B List.

### **IX. PREPARATION OF A, B LIST**

Immediately after the last date of receipt of examination fee, the Head of Institution should prepare the details of candidates in A and B lists. In the case of regular candidates, the details should be prepared in A and B list. The details of Private candidates need be prepared only in B list.

### **X. CANCELLATION OF CANDIDATURE**

If the candidature of a student has to be cancelled under certain circumstances, application for the same should be submitted in the specified format attached ( Annexure C). The application should reach the Secretary to the Commissioner for Government Examinations before 28.02.2017. On the envelope in which the applications are enclosed, it should be noted as "Application for Cancellation of Candidature" in red ink. **The candidature of those who have attended the IT Practical Examination cannot be cancelled.**



## **XI. ADMISSION TICKETS**

The Admission Tickets of the candidates will be issued by the Chief Superintendent at least three days before the commencement of Examination.

## **XII. SCRUTINY, PHOTOCOPY AND REVALUATION OF ANSWER SCRIPTS**


- a. Application from candidates in the form prescribed in Annexure B for scrutiny of valued answer scripts will be accepted only if received within 5 days from the date of publication of results. Fee for scrutiny is Rs. 50/- per paper.
- b. Application for photocopy of answer scripts in Annexure B should be submitted within 5 days from the date of publication of results. The fee for Photocopy of the answer script is fixed as Rs. 200/- per paper. The fee for the Scrutiny, Photocopy and Revaluation should be remitted in cash along with the application to the Head of Institution.
- c. Application for revaluation of answer scripts (Theory Subjects) from the candidates in the form prescribed in Annexure B will be considered. The fee for revaluation of answer scripts is fixed for Rs.400/- per paper. Application for revaluation should be submitted to School Head Master within 5 days from the date of publication of results. Fresh certificates including the revised grade will be distributed through the head of institute to those who procure higher grades. The amount paid for revaluation will also be reimbursed if the candidates have secured higher grade.

- d. After reimbursing the amount to the students who obtained higher grade in revaluation, , the balance amount should be remitted to the treasury under the head "0202-01-102-92 other receipts", from the fee collected for revaluation, scrutiny, photocopy etc.. The photocopy of the chalan and the statements should be despatched to Pareeksha Bhavan forthwith.
- e. The fee for photocopy, scrutiny or revaluation should be remitted in cash to the Principal, Govt.AHSS Kalamandalam along with the application for the same. Belated applications will not be accepted.
- f. The students who secure grade A+ can also apply for revaluation.

### **XIII. IRREGULARITIES**

Any candidate who commit or attempt to commit malpractice in the examination will be expelled immediately and will not be allowed to appear for any other paper subsequently in the examination. Candidates are not allowed to bring with them any written or printed matter. Copying from another candidate or giving convenience to any candidate will be considered as malpractice. If any candidate behaves in any unruly manner either in the examination hall or in the premises of the institution where examination is conducted, will be expelled from the examination by the Chief Superintendent. Any candidate expelled from the examination either for malpractice or for unruly behavior may be further debarred from appearing for subsequent examination for specified number of chance as decided later.

All candidates appearing for the examination should furnish an undertaking that they will abide by all the rules and regulations in force, in respect of the examination.
